## About SRM Institute of Science and Technology

SRM Institute of Science and Technology is one of the premier institutes in India, which was founded in 2002 by the visionary Dr. T. R. Paarivendhar. The institute is known for its high standards in teaching and research. The institute has four sprawling campuses: Kattankulathur campus in Chengalpattu District, Ramapuram and Vadapalani campuses in Chennai, Irungalur in Trichi and the Delhi NCR campus in Modinagar, Ghaziabad – offering a wide range of undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programs in six Faculties – Engineering & Technology, Management, Medicine & Health Sciences, Science & Humanities; and Law & Agricultural Sciences. There are 10 constituent colleges, 18 Schools, 76 Departments, and 10 Centers of Excellence offering 96 UG and 132 PG programs in all four campuses and doctoral programs in over 30 disciplines. SRM has awarded more than 800 Ph.D. agreements in the last five years, and around 3000 research scholars are pursuing research in various disciplines. The total number of students studying on all the university campuses is around 52,000, with more than 1,000 international students. The total teaching staff strength is more than 3,200.



Ever since its inception, a strong commitment to excellence in teaching and research has exhilarated and elevated SRM to be a role model and path-setter for other universities across the country.

The UGC has graded SRM IST as a category-1- 1 institute, and it is included in the list of universities under Category 12 B. The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Ministry of Education, GOI has recognised SRM IST as the highest 'A' grade institution. Also, the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) has ranked 12th position under the university category in 2024. Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) placed SRM IST on 4th position under the category of private and self-financed institutions in the year 2021.

### **Infrastructure**

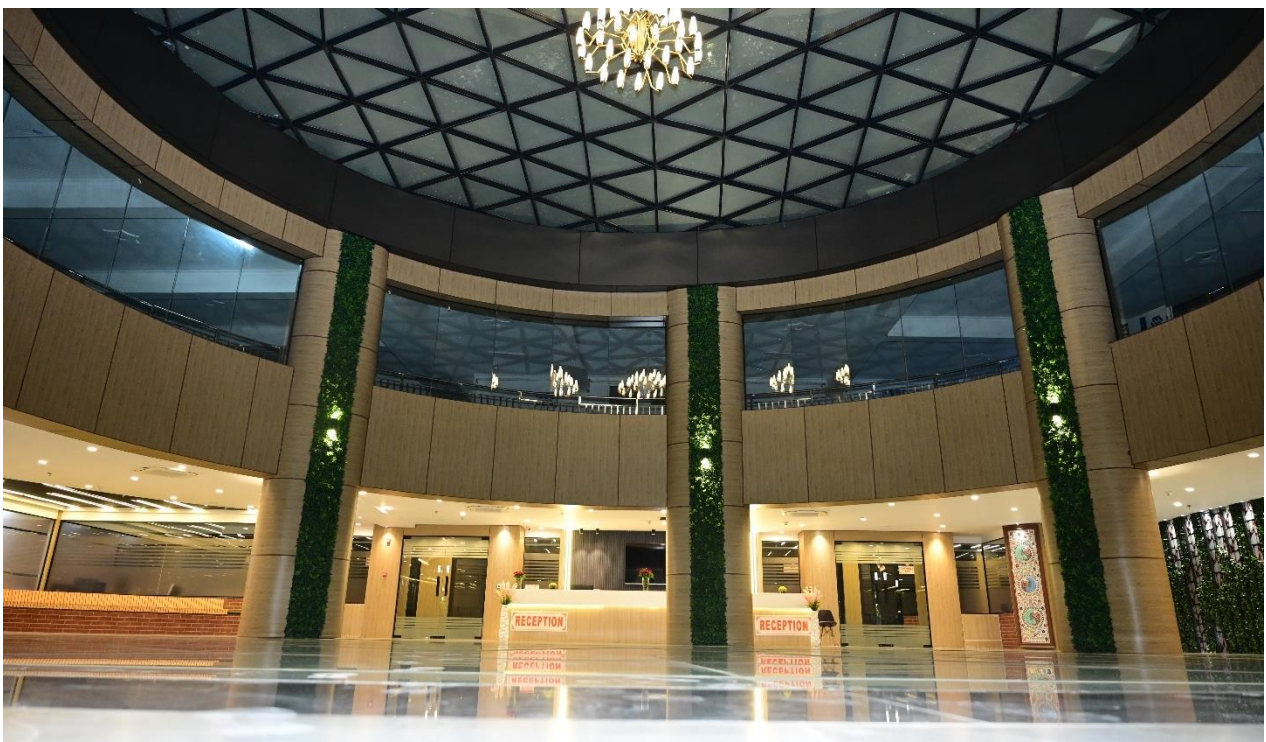

Central Library is available to the students and faculty members. The library is built in a spacious area of 24000 sq. feet and is equipped with RFID connections and automated entry. The library is equipped with an Integrated Library Management System (ILMS). The library also provides a platform for remote access to e-resources, enabling students to use more than 35 LakhsWorld e-books library. It has around 66,200 books and a large database of e-books, e-

journals, encyclopedias, and reference materials on various topics. Nearly 234 printed National and International journals and 34 printed Magazines are subscribed. Subscriptions of all the reputed online journals and databases such as IEEE, ACM Digital Library, Springer, J-Gate Engineering, J-Gate Management, NPTEL, KNIMBUS, DELNET, EBSCO Management, a NDL Magzter Digital Magazine and Newspaper are also available, providing a plethora of information.



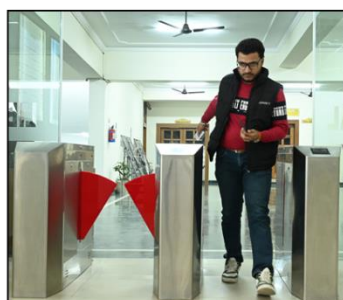

## Semester Abroad Program(SAP)

SRMIST is recognized across the country for its high standards of education, exciting opportunities and excellent placement. To maintain its top position, the University is spearheading with Semester Abroad Program (SAP), a unique initiative providing its students an international exposure and global opportunities. This, we believe, is the first of its kind in India.

Under the Semester Abroad Program the students are allowed to take-up a few courses and /or a Major project in reputed foreign universities for ONE semester. The credits earned in the foreign university through the SAP will be translated into SRM credits, by an approved conversion procedure, and taken for consideration for the award of the degree by SRM IST. After the study period at a foreign university the students return to SRM IST to continue with the degree program for which they were enrolled, and after fulfilling all the necessary conditions laid out in the regulations of SRM IST, the student will become eligible for the award of the degree.

## Placements

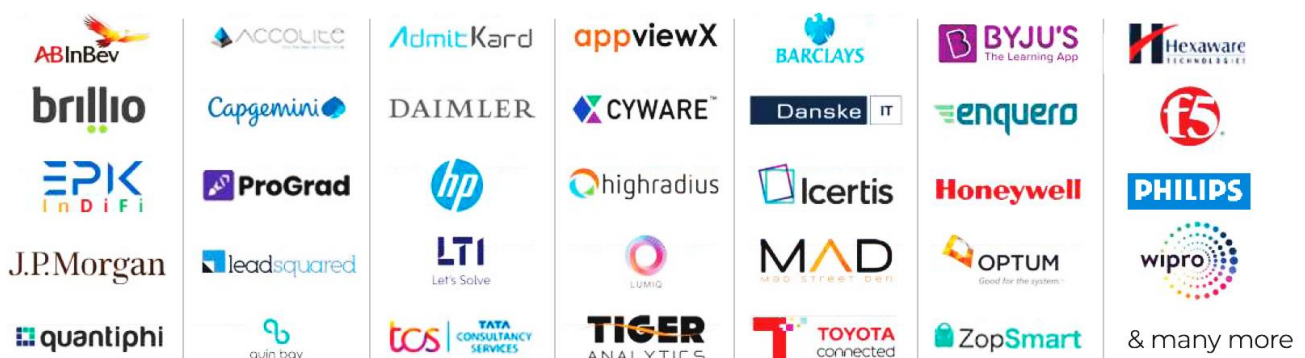
The Foundation has set an impeccable record in engineering placements. The students of the Delhi NCR campus have been placed in all the leading MNCs, Corporate and Government sectors with good packages. It is a matter of pride to our campus that many of our placed students have received three to four offer letters from MNCs and corporate during the placement drive.

In the year 2024-2025, around 81% of the students of all the disciplines were placed in various multinational companies such as Microsoft, JP Morgan, Accolite, Tiger Analytics, AB InBev, Barclays, Honeywell, Ford, Hexaware, Toyota, Bank of American, Philips, HP, Quinbay, spyware, Barclays, Signify, NATWEST etc. This year, the highest package of 20 lakhs per annum is offered to our students by Porter. In the session, 2023-2024 around 1308 companies visited our campus, giving 800 offers to our students.

Around 5% of students opt for higher studies overseas, and the rest venture to become entrepreneurs.

The Hotel Management students of our campus got placed in premium hotels such as Hotel Taj View, Agra; Hotel Golden Tulip, Chandigarh; Le Meridian, Gurugram; Park Inn by Radisson, New Delhi; Hotel The Grand, New Delhi; Hotel Crown Plaza, New Delhi, etc.

### **Incubation Centre: -**

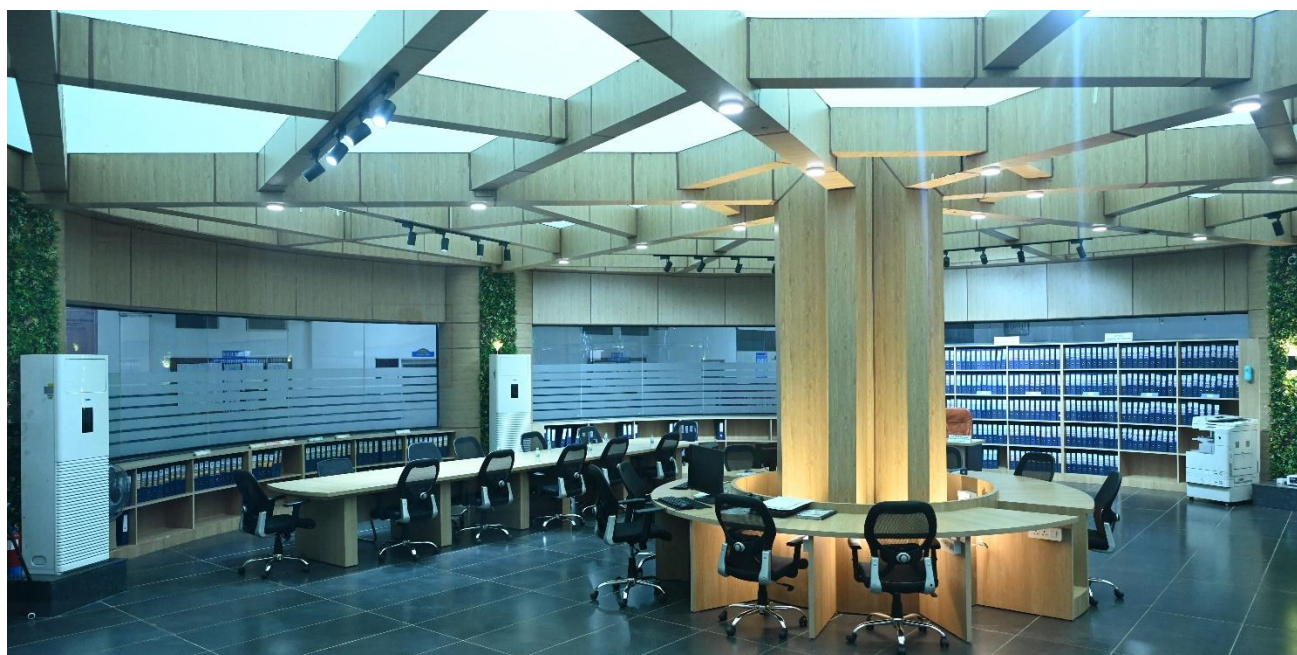

The centre envisions a vibrant space where diverse minds come together, exchanging knowledge, skills, and experiences to unlock the full potential of their innovations.

An electric golf cart indigenously built by SRM IST, NCR Campus, was displayed in RIDE ASIA 2023 held from 14th-16th April 2023 at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. The golf cart was also showcased in DST – PURSE before Hon'ble Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh, DST at New Delhi. The innovative battery pack used in the cart was based on lithium-ion, which is better than traditional lead battery packs. It was designed and developed in-house at the Electric Vehicle Skill Development Centre (ESDC) of the institute campus.



## IQAC-

Integral to educational institutions, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) holds the responsibility of upholding and enhancing the quality of education. IQAC, which is dedicated to ongoing enhancement, is in charge of creating and executing quality standards and evaluation protocols. IQAC at SRM IST, NCR Campus is continuously working as the quality initiative taken by SRM Chennai Campus. Many members have been actively contributing to the IQAC Cell since 2017. Under the able guidance of Dr Dhowmya Bhatt, Dean IQAC, the cell has taken up numerous activities, including Mock visits, Departmental file scrutiny, Criteria file scrutiny, etc., to ensure good quality in accreditation or academic work and the teaching-learning process.





### **Woman Grievances and Retrieval Cell**

### **Alumni Cell**

### **Research and Publications**

Extensive research facilities are provided on the campus to promote innovative research. The students and staff are encouraged to explore new concepts through quality research in emerging areas. Each department has its own laboratories and facilities to handle high-end research. The Department of Automobile Engineering has established the Automotive Electrical and Electronics Lab and Vehicle Dynamics Lab to enhance the research activities among students and staff.

The faculty members of the Delhi-NCR campus are committed to research and published around 395 research articles in various reputed and indexed international journals and conferences. It is noteworthy to mention that 77 books/chapters and 18 patents have been published by the faculty members of different departments during this year.

At present, 263 research scholars are pursuing PhD in various disciplines on this campus. This year, 13 research scholars have been awarded a PhD degree. To promote research activities among faculty members and students, we are conducting workshops, conferences and technical symposiums regularly on campus.

Faculty members, as well as students, are encouraged to take up research activities. Various student chapters of professional societies like IEEE, ISTE, CSI, and NPTEL are opened on the campus, and as a result, different departments have become part of these organisations.
